The calculator is not advised for small rooms, but rather those with a diffuse sound field. You may find value though in small rooms ensuring evenness of absorption across the frequency bands. The web app calculates Sabine, Eyring, Fitzroy, and Arau-Pruchades simultaneously, has a database of about 400 finish/mount configurations and growing, and a cool feature is dynamic ranging between unoccupied and occupied rooms.
